deleting Item #14 and substituting the following therefor:

"14. Radiation Protection Program - Leak testing
on the Americium and Polonium will be made at least
once every three months. This will be accomplished
by taking a dry wipe of the storage container and
place of mount and running a count with a thin
window gas-flow counter."
