On January 9, 2009, Louisiana Energy Services (LES) submitted a Licensing Amendment Request (LAR) to revise the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP), Revision 7, (Reference 1). On July 8, 2009 LES received a Request for Additional Information (RAI) from the NRC regarding the amendment (Reference 2).

Attached as Enclosure 1 are responses to the NRC RAIs 1 through 71. As a result of our responses, page changes were necessary to the FNMCP. The response to RAI 21 is associated with the LES FNMCP Chapter 9 which is a Classified document. The NRC RAI and the LES response are not classified and have been included in this RAI response transmittal. Attached as Enclosure 1 are the NRC RAIs and the LES responses indicating how the FNMCP will be revised in response to the RAI. Attached as Enclosure 2 are the FNMCP page changes, utilizing revision bars, and red line strikethroughs and new text insertion underlines. The LES response for RAI 21 has only the NRC RAI, the LES response, and a reference to the section number in Chapter 9 that will be revised. LES will transmit a subsequent License Amendment Request (LAR) to update Chapter 9 in its entirety and will include this LES commitment (RAI 21 response) in that LAR. Attached as Enclosure 3 is the clean copy (no red line strikethroughs) of the FNMCP incorporating the



responses to RAI 1 through 20 and 22 through 71. Enclosure 3 serves as the technical basis for the changes proposed in the License Amendment Request to the FNMCP.

The enclosures contain security-related information and disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present security vulnerabilities. Therefore, LES requests that the enclosures be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.
