1. Please note that waste processor licensees are required to provide a decommissioning funding plan (DFP) according to 10 CFR 30.35(c)(5), which was revised October 3, 2003.

Please note that 10 CFR 30.35(c)(5) states, waste collectors and waste processors, as defined in 10 CFR Part 20, Appendix G, must provide financial assurance in an amount based on a decommissioning funding plan as described in paragraph (e) of this section. The decommissioning funding plan must include the cost of disposal of the maximum amount (curies) of radioactive material permitted by the license, and the cost of disposal of the maximum quantity, by volume, of radioactive material which could be present at the licensee's facility at any time, in addition to the cost to remediate the licensee's site to meet the license termination criteria of 10 CFR Part 20.
