**Subject: Device Deactivation NR-1203-D-101E**

Dear NRC:

This letter is to advise the NRC that MTI Industries, Inc. of Volo, IL requests to make all devices on license NR-1203-D-101E be made inactive. We discontinued importing Model 1001 as of late 2008 and have sold all remaining inventory, MTI will not continue to distribute this device.

There are no ongoing services for this device as we have discontinued it. Any replacement or warranty claims will be handled using substitute smoke alarms purchased from a NRC licensed manufacturer.

During the life of this license approximately 675,000 smoke alarms were sold into the Marine, RV and residential market. Since smoke alarms have a recommended replacement date of 10 years after manufacture, we expect almost all of the alarms are still in use at this time.

During the life of the license 2003-2009 no changes were made to Model 1001.

Under separate letter we are requesting termination of our distribution license 1223905-01E.
