Bob, in response to the letter that you forwarded dated August 5, 2009, and that NRC received the next day, I have had several discussions with my management. We would like to request that you address generically the statements made on Pages 1 and 2 with regard to NIH's conduct of MARSSIM quality surveys and that you specifically provide additional information to address the items on Pages 3 and 4 for the Flow Building. The questioned items requiring specific responses are scan results, residual tritium activity, instrumentation, instrument efficiencies, and all of the observations.

While we understand that much of this information has been provided either during recent inspection activities, during several phone conversations and emails, and in follow-up correspondence; we appreciate your efforts in compiling this information into one response document.
