The Office of Permit Coordination and Environmental Review of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has completed its review of the Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the FMC Corporation license amendment in Princeton, Mercer County. We offer the following comments for your consideration.

**Bureau of Environmental Radiation (BER)**

Staff of the Radiological Assessment and Decommissioning Section (RADS) of the BER performed a radiological review of the following US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) document for FMC Corporation:

- Nuclear Regulatory Commission Docket No. 030-33542 Notice of availability of Environmental Assessment and finding of no significant impact for license amendment to byproduct materials license No. 29-01035-01, for unrestricted release of the FMC Corporation facility in Princeton, New Jersey.

The BER agrees with the NRC's Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed action to approve the licensee's amendment request to release Building 2 and 22 for unrestricted use.
