This letter refers to your April 22, 2009 correspondence, in response to our March 25, 2009 letter. Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter. Your actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program. In your response to Violation B, you propose that quarterly summaries of occupational exposures be compiled for individuals who work at more than one licensed facility. Please be aware that quarterly summaries may not be sufficient to identify potential radiation exposures in excess of regulatory limits in time to prevent the overexposures from occurring if day-to-day radiation exposures can be high and subject to variation.

No response to this letter is required. Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
