Dear Mr. ViVori:

As I discussed with you on February 4, 1971, packaging for shipment of the 2000 curies of cesium 137 contained in the CES-I-RAD Irradiator is subject to the provisions of 10 CFR Part 71. If, however, the sources are classed as "special form" (Section 71.4(o), 10 CFR Part 71), they will fall outside the definition of "large quantity" (Section 71.4(f)) and will not be subject to Part 71. Enclosed is a copy of 10 CFR Part 71 for your reference.

If packaging of the material is not subject to Part 71, you should apply for a byproduct material license pursuant to 10 CFR Part 30 for packaging of the material for transport from Falls Church, Virginia to Northern Virginia Community College, Annandale, Virginia. A copy of 10 CFR Part 30 is also enclosed.

An application submitted pursuant to Part 71 should be submitted to the attention of Mr. Robert L. Stevenson (telephone 973-7457), Division of Materials Licensing, Fuel Fabrication and Transportation Branch.
