
Dear Mr. Struckmeyer,

I am writing to request that the Agency re-issue our referenced license to indicate a change in name from PerkinElmer Health Sciences, Inc. to PerkinElmer, Inc.

The licensee name change does not affect the ownership of licensed activities. We have reviewed NUREG-1556 Vol.15, NRC information notice 89-25, REV1, and determined that this name change does not involve a change in control. PerkinElmer, Inc. has nearly completed the name change in product literature and labels and expects to complete this transition over the year 2009. Additional time beyond 2009 is requested for catalog products already packaged and labeled for shipment. We confirm the new labels and literature will contain the same symbols and wording as those in current use and that only the name of the company will be changed. 
