RAI 101 addresses Groundwater and RAI 104 addresses Liquid Radioactive Release, as discussed in Section 2.4 of the Final Safety Analysis Report, as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 5.

Reference 1 and 2 anticipated the responses would be provided by September 14, 2009 and September 16, 2009, respectively. UniStar Nuclear Energy is currently assessing the impact the responses to RAI 101 Questions 02.04.12-9 to 02.04.12-11 and RAI 104 Question 02.04.13-4 have with respect to the entire COLA, and requires additional time to determine when an answer will be provided.
