### NRC NAMES NEW SENIOR RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT PERRY NUCLEAR POWER PLANT



The U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected Mark Marshfield as the new senior resident inspector at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant in Perry, Ohio, roughly 35 miles northeast of Cleveland.

Most recently, Marshfield was a resident inspector at the Ginna nuclear power plant located in Rochester, N.Y. He joined the NRC in Region 1 as a reactor engineer in 2002.

Prior to joining the agency, Marshfield served more than 20 years in the Navy. He was an executive officer aboard the ballistic missile submarine USS Alaska and also aboard a submarine repair ship USS Simon Lake. Marshfield was a director of the Navy Nuclear Power School in Florida and the commanding officer for Navy recruiting in parts of upstate New York. He graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy with a Bachelors of Science degree in physics and received a Masters of Science degree from the Georgia Institute of Technology.

“Mark Marshfield is an excellent inspector with a firm commitment to safety. He will help the NRC fulfill its mission of protecting people and the environment by helping ensure the Perry plant operates at the high standards set by the NRC,” Region III Administrator Mark Satorius said.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear plant site has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency’s eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring major work projects and interacting with plant workers and the public. Marshfield can be reached at (440) 259-3610.
