I. SECY-09-0125 – South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company (South Texas Project Units 3 and 4), Request for Extension of Time to File Appeal

The Commission¹ approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the request of applicant South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC) to extend the time for filing an appeal, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.311(d), of the Board's decision in LBP-09-21, partially ruling on an intervention petition in this combined license proceeding. The Memorandum and Order denies STPNOC's request as unnecessary, because LBP-09-21 is not yet ripe for review

II. SECY-09-0127 - Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC (Materials License Application) – Applicant's Motion to Transfer Case to the Commission

The Commission¹ approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the motion of applicant Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC (Pa'ina) to remove the proceeding from the Board and transfer the case to the Commission. The Order denies Pa'ina's request to transfer the case to the Commission.
