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## RAI 10.02.03-1

## **QUESTION:**

Please modify FSAR Section 10.2.5.1 and Commitment 10.2-1 to state that the as-built material property data will be provided in the FSAR update after procurement and prior to initial fuel load.

## **RESPONSE:**

STPNOC will provide the low pressure turbine rotor as-built material property data that supports the turbine rotor design specified in subsection 10.2.3.2 after procurement and prior to initial fuel load.

As a result of this RAI response, COLA Revision 3, Part 2, Tier 2, Subsection 10.2.5.1 will be revised as follows with changes indicated by gray shading:

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.71(e), STPNOC will update the FSAR to identify the assemble turbine material property data that supports the material properties used in the turbine rotor design specified in Subsection 10.2.3.2, after procurement and prior to initial fuel load (COM 10.2-1). Operating procedures to assure sufficient turbine warm-up time, as required by subsection 10.2.3.2, are prepared in accordance with the guidelines in FSAR Section 13.5.
