ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONCERNING APPLICATION FOR
AMENDMENT TO LICENSE, CONTROL NO. 144040

Dear Lcdo. De Jesus Rozas:

This is in reference to your application dated August 12, 2009 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 52-31281-02 to name Dr. Carlos Chévere and Dr. Julio Diaz as authorized users for your gamma stereotactic radiosurgery (GSR) unit.

It is our understanding that neither Dr. Chévere nor Dr. Diaz has been previously named as GSR authorized user on an NRC or Agreement State license, and neither holds a specialty board certification recognized by the NRC for GSR use.

In order for NRC Region I to name Dr. Chévere and Dr. Diaz as GSR authorized users, it is necessary to provide the following additional information:

- a. Description of the training and experience listed in 10 CFR 35.690(b)(1) and (b)(2);
- b. Documentation of completion of the GSR vendor training program, including device operation, safety procedures, and clinical use; AND
- c. Written certification, signed by a preceptor GSR authorized user, that the above training and experience has been satisfactorily completed and that a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized has been achieved.

NRC Form 313A(AUS) may be used to document this information for each individual. This form is available on the NRC's website at [http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc313a\(aus\).pdf](http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc313a(aus).pdf). The pertinent sections are Part I, Sections 3a, 3d (including the top of page 4), and 3e; plus the second, third, fourth, and fifth sections of Part II.

Upon receipt of this information, we will determine if it is necessary to submit it and your application dated August 12, 2009 to NRC Headquarters for their consideration.
