General Chemical Corporation

The licensee had initially requested termination of its license on September 30, 2005, and the licensee had stated that all licensed material had been removed from its facilities. NRC inspection conducted on May 23, 2002 determined that the licensee had removed material from its Marcus Hook facility, and only the Claymont facility had the material. A subsequent inspection on April 24, 2007, determined that the Claymont facility had been closed since 2005. The inspection report documented that the plant had been closed since 2004 and the licensee had leak test results until 2004, and that the licensee had documentation demonstrating that all material had been transferred from the facility in 2004.

We have received a second request for the termination of the license (dated August 15, 2009). Based on the documentation provided by the licensee, it appears that the licensee did not possess any licensed material since 2005. We can accept the licensee's request dated September 30, 2005, and the subsequent documents to terminate the license.
