Dear Mr. Palmer:

This is in reference to your letter dated August 13, 2009 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-25375-01MD. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. 10 CFR 32.72(b)(2)(ii) states, in part, that a pharmacist may work as an authorized nuclear pharmacist if the individual meets the requirements specified in 10 CFR 35.55(b). Please provide the following documentation of training and experience:
 - a. 700 hours in a structured educational program consisting of both didactic training and supervised practical experience in a nuclear pharmacy in the subjects identified in 10 CFR 35.55(b)(1).
 - b. Written certification, signed by a preceptor authorized nuclear pharmacist, that the individual has satisfactorily completed the training and experience requirements in 10 CFR 35.55(b)(1), and that the individual has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized nuclear pharmacist.

NRC Form 313A(ANP) (attached) may be used to document this information.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region I Office and refer to Mail Control No. 144069. Please note that you may not reply to this letter by return e-mail. Your reply must be in writing by letter or facsimile (610-337-5269). If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
