ORDER
(Regarding Oral Argument and Future Course of Proceeding)

This is to notify the parties that the Licensing Board plans to conduct oral argument in October on the Intervenors' five new contentions, and the related issue of the mootness of Contention 7. Significant parts of the argument may be closed to the public, in order to prevent any inappropriate disclosure of sensitive information concerning the Applicant's May 2009 Mitigative Strategies Report and related information, based on 10 C.F.R. § 2.390(d)(1) – a provision the parties failed to cite in their recent Joint Brief but which appears to us to constitute the regulatory authority for nondisclosure of such security-related SUNSI concerning the physical protection of nuclear power plants, and thus to warrant the use of appropriate procedures to assure that such nondisclosure is not compromised in any adjudicatory processes. The Board will address the conduct of the oral argument in greater detail in a future order, as well as address the future conduct of the proceeding more broadly in a formal scheduling order to be issued when all members of the board are available to confer appropriately on these matters.

In the meantime, the parties shall, on or before October 1, 2009, file statements of their availability during the last half of October for the oral argument, which will be held in the ASLBP hearing room in Rockville, Maryland. The Board will thereafter set a definite date for the oral argument.
