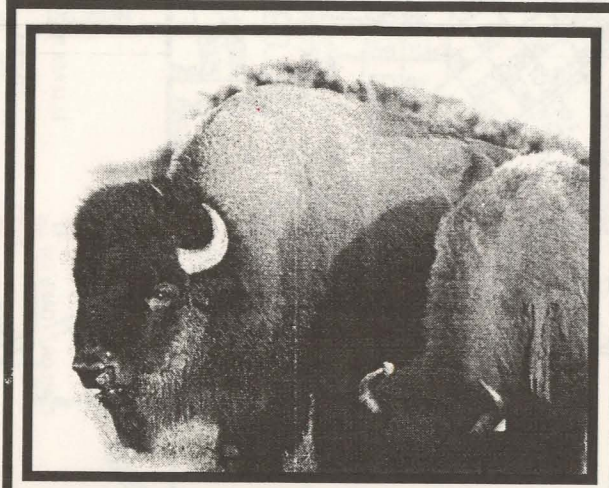

GREEN COUNTRY

In Green Country you can take a trip down memory lane by way of historic Route 66. The "Mother Road" cuts through the heart of Green Country, and lets you get your kicks visiting museums, neon diners, one-of-a-kind art deco structures, totem poles, flowing rivers, small town treasures and big city excitement.

The past comes to life in Green Country at the Woolacoc Museum, Ranch and Wildlife Preserve, a living monument to the American West where buffalo and other wildlife roam and natural history plays out through art and artifacts. You'll also find the West abundantly displayed at the Gilcrease Museum, and the whole world of art awaits you at the Philbrook Museum of Art.

Route 66 is just one road among hundreds that wind their way to special places in Green Country. There are roads that span the mountain tops on the Tallman Drive, lead to the Tall Grass Prairie and flow from the Ozark Hills. Roads that lead to rapids, log cabins, secluded fishing holes, dreamy beds and breakfast cottages, antique shopping and tribal capitals for Cherokee, Creek and Osage Indians. Best of all, in Green Country, are the roads least traveled. The roads that lead to only a little peace and relaxation.

SEQUOYAH COUNTY ATTRACTIONS

Blue Ribbon Downs
Oklahoma's family oriented pan-mutual race track is located two miles west of downtown Sallisaw on Hwy 64 west. Covered seating, an enclosed climate-controlled clubhouse with dining facilities and year-round simulcast of top thoroughbred races ensure your comfort and pleasure.

Sallisaw Rodeo
This has been an annual event since 1944, and draws over 10,000 people to Green Country. Sponsored and operated by the Sallisaw Lion's Club and the Sallisaw Lion's Rodeo, Inc. The twelve event rodeo is PWSA sanctioned and attracts 175 to 200 participants.

Golf Courses
Bring your clubs and enjoy your favorite sport! Shadow Creek Country Club in Sallisaw and East Lake Hills, 15 miles northwest of Sallisaw offer 18-hole courses with grass greens. Please check with the Chamber of Commerce for details.

Stanley Tubbs Memorial Library
A renovated Missouri-Pacific Railroad Station houses Sallisaw's public library. The exterior of the building remains true to the original structure built over 75 years ago.

14 Flags Museum
The 14 Flags Museum is located east of downtown Sallisaw on Cherokee Ave. Built in 1845, it is the restored cabin of Judge Franklin Fraulhaber, a pioneer lawyer of Sequoyah County. The museum contains everything a pioneer from this area.

Sallisaw - Sequoyah's Home Site
Sequoyah, the Cherokee soldier and teacher, gained worldwide fame when he devised the Cherokee syllabary. His statue is in the Nation's Capitol as one of Oklahoma's two greatest men. The giant redwood trees of California are named for him.
