SUBJECT: PROPOSED AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

You were informed of the impending Agreement between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the State of New Jersey, whereby the NRC will relinquish regulatory authority for certain licenses of byproduct, source, and special nuclear material.

We also explained that your NRC license, which authorized licensed activities to be performed in New Jersey and at temporary job sites and/or permanent facilities anywhere in the United States where NRC maintains jurisdiction (non-Agreement States), required an amendment prior to the transfer.

This action is necessary since authorization to conduct licensed activities at temporary job sites and/or permanent facilities in NRC-regulated states will no longer be valid once the Agreement is signed and New Jersey assumes regulatory authority.

We asked that you review your current program and decide if you wish to continue unlimited licensed activities in States that are under NRC jurisdiction. In your response, you requested that NRC issue you a new license authorizing licensed activities in the State of New Jersey. You also requested to maintain your NRC license which authorizes licensed activities in the United States where NRC maintains jurisdiction for regulating licensed material (non-Agreement States).

We have issued you a new license (enclosed), according to your request, which will be transferred to the State of New Jersey and will become effective September 30, 2009. In addition, we have amended your current NRC license (enclosed) to only authorize licensed activities in non-Agreement States. Please note that the changes made to your current NRC license are printed in **bold** font.


