#### STATE OF UTAH'S UPDATE TO ITS VIEWS ON HOW TO PROCEED

In its June 19, 2009 *Views on How the Commission Should Proceed*, the State of Utah advised the Commission that the defendants intended to appeal the Utah federal district court's May 15, 2009, decision relating to the scope of the Northwest Interstate Compact's authority.

The State of Utah, the Northwest Interstate Compact on Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management *et al.*, and the Rocky Mountain Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact timely appealed the district court's decision to the 10<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals. The appeals are docketed under case Nos. 09-4122, 09-4123 and 09-4124 and consolidated for procedural purposes. Eight of ten low-level radioactive waste compacts (33 states) and the Council of State Governments are supporting Appellants' appeal, either as parties or as *amici curiae*. The parties completed briefing on September 28, 2009, and await the court's scheduling of oral argument.
