By application dated August 13, 2009, QSA Global, Inc. (QSA) submitted an amendment request for Certificate of Compliance No. 9027 for the Model No. 741-OP package. This request for additional information (RAI) identifies information needed by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff in connection with its review of the Licensing Drawings of the Model No. 741-OP Projector.

- 1-1 Revise the SAR to state that, as part of the maintenance program for the Model No. 741-OP package, fasteners which are important to the safety and require replacement should only be replaced by fasteners which meet a widely accepted industry standard (e.g., American Society for Testing and Materials).

The replacement fasteners should have mechanical properties that are superior or equal to the nominal properties of the fasteners currently in service.

This information is needed to determine compliance with 10 CFR 71.31(c).

- 1-2 Specify the welding codes used for the welding, inspection, and repair of the overpacks that are currently being fabricated.

The welding codes used for the welding, inspection, and repair of the overpacks are not specified on the licensing drawings.
