Hi Matt,

INIS does not need to submit an FNMC Plan because the facility only handles depleted uranium and does not possess any special nuclear material. Also, Part 74 does not apply to INIS, except some reporting requirements associated with Part 40 which are similar to certain reporting requirements in Part 74.

Hope it helps to answer your MC&A question.

Tom,

Jane said you might be able to help me with an MC&A question. International Isotopes (INIS) is preparing an application for a depleted uranium deconversion facility in Hobbs, NM. Since INIS will only handle depleted uranium, do they need to submit an FNMC plan separate from their application? Can their MC&A procedures be incorporated into the application?

They handle depleted uranium (up to 22 million lbs of UF₆ throughput per year) and do not anticipate any foreign interest in the material. They currently have a small Part 40 license (docket 40-9058) for their Idaho Falls, Idaho, UF₄ deconversion facility, which does not require an FNMC plan. As part of that license, they make an annual report of 0 to comply with Part 74. They indicated the new deconversion facility would have the same level of reports.

I appreciate any input you can provide.
