**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss project management issues and project status related to the AREVA Enrichment Services LLC (AES) license application for a gas centrifuge uranium enrichment facility, proposed to be constructed in Bonneville County, Idaho. The meeting agenda is in Attachment 2.

**DISCUSSION:**

Mr. Mike Weber, Director of the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, welcomed participants to the first AES management meeting concerning the proposed Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility (EREF).
