## SNM-1107 LICENSE APPLICATION AND PHYSICAL SECURITY PLAN-REVISIONS SUBJECT:

Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (WEC) hereby requests a SNM-1107 license amendment to approve the enclosed revision of the Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility (CFFF) Physical Security Plan (PSP). The proposed revision addresses a project which has been initiated to expand the Controlled Access Area (CAA). A revision to Chapter 1.0 of the SNM-1107 License Application and the Physical Security plan are required to authorize the expanded CAA. The License Application revision has been transmitted by WEC letter LTR-RAC-09-52-P which includes a Project Description and Schedule. Once fully implemented WEC intends to; 1) revise the Site Emergency Plan under the provisions provided in Safety Condition S-2 of SNM-1107 and in accordance with 10 CFR 70.32(i); revise the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan and Plan under the provisions provided in Safeguards Condition SG-1.1 of SNM-1107 and in accordance with 10 CFR 70.32(c); and 3) revise the Integrated Safety Analysis Summary Site and Structures document in accordance with 10 CFR 70.72. This amendment request for the expanded CAA does not alter the conclusions of the accident analysis contained within the Integrated Safety Analysis summaries and the revisions are solely focused on the CAA expansion. This project has been discussed at length with members of your staff and the office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response.

Detailed security related information on this project is provided in the enclosures. Enclosure 1 details the methods which will be complied with to ensure the requirements of the PSP are not compromised during project installation. Enclosure 2 contains the proposed revision of the Physical Security Plan. This revision is predicated on the assumption that the previous amendment request for the PSP (LTR-RAC-09-62, Dated 8/19/2009) has been approved or is approved concurrent with this application.
