In the referenced letter, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) submitted an application for a combined license (COL) for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 to be located in Miami-Dade County, Florida in accordance with the requirements contained in 10 CFR 52. The COL Application was supplemented by FPL letters L-2009-145 dated June 30, 2009, L-2009-174 dated July 21, 2009, and L-2009-146 and L-2009-185 dated August 7, 2009.

The NRC notified FPL, by letter dated September 4, 2009, that the FPL COL application for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 is acceptable for docketing. In that September 4th letter and accompanying Enclosure 1, the staff requested additional information in the areas of Geology and Seismology, Geotechnical, Hydrology, and Structural Engineering in order to develop a complete integrated review schedule.

FPL plans to submit its response to the staff's Enclosure 1 request for additional information within 30 to 45 days of the date of this letter.
