Please let me know some good dates and times for you and your site selection consultants for this call early next week. Kirk LaGory of Argonne has agreed to arrange for a conference call bridge number.

1. Please elaborate on the thought process and rationale involved in your site selection process, including but not necessarily limited to some more information (other than the numerical rankings) of how and why you pared the 8 candidate sites down to 3--i.e., perhaps more of the qualitative than the quantitative analysis and rationale.
2. Putting the numerical rankings aside, for what reasons were Candidate Sites N (Belle River) and F (Greenwood) selected over Sites A and C?
3. Why did you choose to eliminate Sites A and C when their numerical rankings were fairly close to that for Site F?
4. Again putting the numerical rankings aside, for what reasons were Sites W3, W2 and W1 eliminated?

Our goal is to try to gain a better understanding of your selection process, to allow us to develop a strong justification for possibly visiting fewer than 7 alternative sites (i.e., the top 2 vs. the top 4 vs. all 7). We will try to come up with some specific questions and send them to you before the call, but I figured that you and your consultants would do most of the talking initially to address the issues I identified above, and that we might have some follow-up questions based on what you tell us.

Randy,

We are currently conducting preliminary planning the Fermi 3 alternative sites visit, including how many of the sites we would want to visit. Assuming we would need to spend about 1.5-2.5 hours per site and given the travel times between sites, how many days would you estimate we would need to visit:

- Two sites--Belle River/St. Clair and Greenwood?
- Four sites-- Belle River/St. Clair, Greenwood, Greenfield Site A, and Greenfield Site C?
- Seven sites-- Belle River/St. Clair, Greenwood, and Greenfield Sites A, C W3, W2 and W1?

This is for are early planning purposes only. We are currently reviewing Detroit Edison's site selection process (Section 9.3 of the Environmental Report) to determine how many of which of these sites need to be visited to justify the conclusions of the EIS.
