On October 6, 2009, Mr. Fendt sent an e-mail detailing perceived errors in the license amendment issued recently to the licensee. Item 9.D. in the amendment still refers to the use for the Krypton-85 source, which was transferred, and not the Cesium-137 source which the licensee still possesses.

10/8/2009 10:20 After examining the license, I went over the changes that would be needed in the license and to see if Mr. Fendt observed any others. (1) Under Authorized Use, the second set should only cite 9.C. and E. Item 9.D referred to the Krypton-85 source which was transferred. (2) The fourth set should refer to the J.L. Shepherd device as pointed out by the licensee. (3) License Condition 10.B should read "Licensed material in Items 6.A, 6.B, 6.C, and 6.E ..." instead of "... 6.A through 6.E ..." (4) License Condition 10.C should not reference Item 6.D. Mr. Fendt agreed that the amendment caused a number of unintended changes in the license which were missed by both the license reviewer and himself.
