SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Wood:

In letter dated September 15, 2009, Mr. Jeremy Waller, Director of Operations contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that he wished to terminate the Niles Steel Tank Company NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the final status of the program. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and no residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities remains.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. The facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number is hereby terminated.
