In letter dated October 9, 2008, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and requested termination of your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys, and has concluded that licensable material has been removed from your facility, and that any residual licensed material does not exceed current NRC unrestricted use criteria. An environmental assessment for this action was performed and noticed in the Federal Register on September 24, 2009, Volume. 74, No. 184, pages 48786-48787.
