The purpose of this letter is to respond to the request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated September 18, 2009 (Reference). This RAI addresses Radiation Protection, as discussed in Section 12.3 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI No. 157, Questions 12.03-12.04-3 and 12.03-12.04-4. A response to these questions will be provided to the NRC by November 2, 2009.
