Mr. Macatangay:

In a letter dated Tuesday, September 29, 2009 (copy attached), Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI) requested an amendment to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 12-16941-01 to incorporate a location change of PSI's Kalamazoo, Michigan facility.

Per our telephone conversation yesterday afternoon, it appears that NRC Region III's current lead time on processing license amendment requests is ninety (90) days. Unfortunately, PSI did not have access to the new facility (in order to develop a facility diagram to submit with the amendment request) until the end of September 2009, at which time PSI faxed the amendment request to NRC Region III (ATTN: Materials Licensing). PSI was not aware of the (current) 90-day lead time and presumed that a thirty (30) notification of location change was adequate.

PSI's Kalamazoo facility is currently in the process of moving to the new office space; however, the six (6) moisture/density gauges will not be stored at the new facility (awaiting license authorization) at this time. Unfortunately, PSI's lease on the currently-licensed facility in Kalamazoo (7692 Sprinkle Road) expires at the end of October 2009, and PSI is now in a critical position of having to respectfully request expedited processing of the 09/29/2009 licensing action (Control No. 318546).

If PSI's request for expedited processing of the pending license action cannot be granted or if the license action cannot be completed by 10/31/2009, PSI respectfully requests authorization to transfer the six (6) portable gauges to the new facility (3614 Lake Street, Kalamazoo) under the temporary job site storage provisions implied in Condition 10.B of the (current) license. PSI is requesting authorization to transfer the gauges to the new facility before 10/31/2009 in the interest of greater security and control of the devices, rather of having to continue to store the gauges at the currently-licensed location after the Manager/RSO and all other personnel have moved.
