Dear Mr. Edlebeck:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 14 to your NRC Material License No. 21-16955-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9892 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

In correspondence dated July 7, 2009, you indicated that you wished to release for unrestricted use the former storage location of your portable gauge storage cabinet. The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former storage location and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this storage location and it is suitable for unrestricted use.

This also refers to the telephone conversation between you and me on October 6, 2009, regarding finite possession limits in Subitem Nos. 8A and 8B of your license. You requested a maximum limit of 15 sealed sources for each Subitem which is reflected on your amended license. If my understanding is incorrect in this matter, please contact me immediately at 630-829-9892.

A copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
