**This also refers to the telephone discussion between you and me on October 27, 2009, concerning the new Alternate Radiation Safety Officer (ARSO) appointment requested in your letter dated July 22, 2009.**

**For future reference, please do not submit resumes or curricula vitae in support of authorized user or RSO requests as they frequently contain information that we do not need to review and must protect from release to the public.**

**Please review NUREG 1556, Vol. 7, Section 8.7.1 for guidance on how to prepare such amendment requests.**

**In addition, in our October 27, 2009, telephone discussion you mentioned that your radiation safety program is currently not very active. I reminded you to consider the requirements in 10 CFR 30.36(d) (2), (3), and (4) if your program remains inactive.**


In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result

from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
