The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the response to request for additional information (RAI) 118. RAI 118 addresses Inspections, Tests, Analyses, and Acceptance Criteria (ITAAC), as discussed in Section 14.3 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

Reference 1 anticipated that the response to RAI 118 would be provided by October 30, 2009. Reference 2 provided an updated schedule of responses to RAI 118, Question 14.03.02-2, Parts A through N. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to respond to RAI 118,
