NRC STAFF CERTIFICATION OF  
LICENSING SUPPORT NETWORK SUPPLEMENTATION

By Order, dated July 2005, as modified by Orders dated February 9, 2006 and July 6, 2007,<sup>1</sup> the Pre-License Application Presiding Officer (PAPO) Board required that after a Licensing Support Network (LSN) participant's initial certification of its LSN collection, and after the Department of Energy (DOE) certifies its LSN document collection, each LSN participant shall, on or before the first of each month, certify on a monthly basis that it has duly supplemented its LSN collection with any additional documentary material discovered or created after the time of its initial certification. On January 16, 2009, the Chief Administrative Judge established three licensing board, denoted construction authorization boards (CABs). See [HLW] Establishment of Atomic Safety and Licensing Boards, 74 Fed. Reg. 4477 (Jan. 26, 2009). On June 19, 2009, the Chief Administrative Judge established a fourth licensing board, denoted Construction Authorization Board 04 (CAB-04). See [HLW] Establishment of Atomic

Safety and Licensing Boards, 74 Fed. Reg. 30644 (Jun. 26, 2009). The jurisdiction of the PAPO Board was terminated on June 5, 2009, Sixth Case Management Order (Regarding State of Nevada's Access to Classified Information) (June 5, 2009) (unpublished), at 12, however the continuing monthly certification requirement remains effective. 10 C.F.R. § 2.1011(b)(2); see CAB Case Management Order #1, January 29, 2009, at 2. The NRC staff ("Staff") last filed a certification of the supplementation of its LSN collection on September 30, 2009.

On October 30, 2009, Staff filed the "NRC Staff Motion for Leave to File an Amended LSN Privilege Log Certification and Motion to Extend November 1, 2009 Privilege Log Certification Deadline," ("Motion") on which Construction Authorization Board-04 ("the Board") has not yet ruled. As stated in the Motion, the Staff has completed its monthly LSN certification. Motion at 4. Accordingly, appended to this filing is the certification of Ms. Alicia J. Mullins, the official responsible for the administration of the Staff's efforts to identify and make available supplementary documentary material via the LSN, and the Staff's cumulative privilege log. However, as discussed in the Motion, the Staff cannot include the certification by counsel required by the "Revised Second Case Management Order," July 6, 2007, at Appendix C; and "Fifth Case Management Order," November 1, 2007 at 6. See Motion at 4-5. Following the Board's ruling on the Motion, the Staff intends to file its privilege log certification.
