## **LEGAL STANDARDS AND AUTHORITY**

### **§ 2.206 Requests for Action Under This Subpart:**

- (a) Any person may file a request to institute a proceeding pursuant to § 2.202 to modify, suspend, or revoke a license, or for any other action as may be proper. Requests must be addressed to the Executive Director for Operations and must be filed either by hand delivery to the NRC's Offices at 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland; by mail or telegram addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; or by electronic submissions, for example, via facsimile, Electronic Information Exchange, e-mail, or CD-ROM. Electronic submissions must be made in a manner that enables the NRC to receive, read, authenticate, distribute, and archive the submission, and process and retrieve it a single page at a time. Detailed guidance on making electronic submissions can be obtained by visiting the NRC's Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/site-help/e-submittals.html>, by calling (301) 415-0439, by e-mail to [EIE@nrc.gov](mailto:EIE@nrc.gov); or by writing the Office of Information Services, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001. The request must specify the action requested and set forth the facts that constitute the basis for the request. The Executive Director for Operations will refer the request to the Director of the NRC office with responsibility for the subject matter of the request for appropriate action in accordance with paragraph (b) of this section.
- (b) Within a reasonable time after a request pursuant to paragraph (a) of this section has been received, the Director of the NRC office with responsibility for the subject matter of the request shall either institute the requested proceeding in accordance with this subpart or shall advise the person who made the request in writing that no proceeding will be instituted in whole or in part, with respect to the request, and the reasons for the decision.
- (c)(1) Director's decisions under this section will be filed with the Office of the Secretary. Within twenty-five (25) days after the date of the Director's decision under this section that no proceeding will be instituted or other action taken in whole or in part, the Commission may on its own motion review that decision, in whole or in part, to determine if the Director has abused his discretion. This review power does not limit in any way either the Commission's supervisory power over delegated staff actions or the Commission's power to consult with the staff on a formal or informal basis regarding institution of proceedings under this section.
- (2) No petition or other request for Commission review of a Director's decision under this section will be entertained by the Commission.
- (3) The Secretary is authorized to extend the time for Commission review on its own motion of a Director's denial under paragraph (c) of this section.

**§ 50.7 Employee protection.**

- (a) Discrimination by a Commission licensee, an applicant for a Commission license, or a contractor or subcontractor of a Commission licensee or applicant against an employee for engaging in certain protected activities is prohibited. Discrimination includes discharge and other actions that relate to compensation, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment. The protected activities are established in section 211 of the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974, as amended, and in general are related to the administration or enforcement of a requirement imposed under the Atomic Energy Act or the Energy Reorganization Act.
  - (1) The protected activities include but are not limited to: (i) Providing the Commission or his or her employer information about alleged violations of either of the statutes named in paragraph (a) introductory text of this section or possible violations of requirements imposed under either of those statutes;
  - (ii) Refusing to engage in any practice made unlawful under either of the statutes named in paragraph (a) introductory text or under these requirements if the employee has identified the alleged illegality to the employer; (iii) Requesting the Commission to institute action against his or her employer for the administration or enforcement of these requirements; (iv) Testifying in any Commission proceeding, or before Congress, or at any Federal or State proceeding regarding any provision (or proposed provision) of either of the statutes named in paragraph (a) introductory text. (v) Assisting or participating in, or is about to assist or participate in, these activities.
- (2) These activities are protected even if no formal proceeding is actually initiated as a result of the employee assistance or participation. (3) This section has no application to any employee alleging discrimination prohibited by this section who, acting without direction from his or her employer (or the employer's agent), deliberately causes a violation of any requirement of the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974, as amended, or the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. (b) Any employee who believes that he or she has been discharged or otherwise discriminated against by any person for engaging in protected activities specified in paragraph (a)(1) of this section may seek a remedy for the discharge or discrimination through an administrative proceeding in the Department of Labor. The administrative proceeding must be initiated within 180 days after an alleged violation occurs. The employee may do this by filing a complaint alleging the violation with the Department of Labor, Employment Standards Administration, Wage and Hour Division. The department of Labor may order reinstatement, back pay, and compensatory damages. (c) A violation of paragraph (a), (e), or (f) of this section by a Commission licensee, an applicant for a Commission license, or a contractor or subcontractor of a Commission licensee or applicant may be grounds for-- (1) Denial, revocation, or suspension of the license. (2) Imposition of a civil penalty on the licensee, applicant, or a contractor or subcontractor of the licensee or applicant.
- (3) Other enforcement action. (d) Actions taken by an employer, or others, which adversely affect an employee may be predicated upon nondiscriminatory grounds. The prohibition applies when the adverse action occurs because the employee has engaged in protected activities. An employee's engagement in protected activities does not automatically render him or her

immune from discharge or discipline for legitimate reasons or from adverse action dictated by non prohibited considerations. (e)(1) Each licensee and each applicant for a license shall prominently post the revision of NRC Form 3, "Notice to Employees," referenced in 10 CFR 19.11(c). This form must be posted at locations sufficient to permit employees protected by this section to observe a copy on the way to or from their place of work. Premises must be posted not later than 30 days after an application is docketed and remain posted while the application is pending before the Commission, during the term of the license, and for 30 days following license termination. (2) Copies of NRC Form 3 may be obtained by writing to the Regional Administrator of the appropriate U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Regional Office listed in appendix D to part 20 of this chapter, by calling (301) 415-5877, via e-mail to [forms@nrc.gov](mailto:forms@nrc.gov), or by visiting the NRC's Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov> and selecting forms from the index found on the home page. (f) No agreement affecting the compensation, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment, including an agreement to settle a complaint filed by an employee with the Department of Labor pursuant to section 211 of the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974, as amended, may contain any provision which would prohibit, restrict, or otherwise discourage an employee from participating in protected activity as defined in paragraph (a)(1) of this section including, but not limited to, providing information to the NRC or to his or her employer on potential violations or other matters within NRC's regulatory responsibilities.

#### **SPECIFIC REQUEST**

The undersigned Petitioner requests that,

- (1) the NRC immediately investigate apparent violations of 10 CFR 50.7 by U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Licensee Exelon Corporation et al. in taking adverse actions against Petitioner in refusing to hire [him] solely because of his past, present, and continuing "protected activity" within the meaning of 10 C.F.R. 50.7 as described above; and
- (2) the NRC issue a Confirmatory Order and Notice of Violation imposing a civil monetary penalty against Exelon et al., in the sum total amount of \$100,000; and
- (4) the NRC issue a Confirmatory Order and Notice of Violation imposing a civil monetary penalty against the Licensee's Chief Executive Officer, Mr. John W. Rowe in the sum total amount of \$100,000; and
- (5) the NRC issue a Confirmatory Order preventing Mr. Rowe from participating in NRC licensed activities for a period of not less than five-years; and
- (6) the NRC issue a Confirmatory Order requiring the Licensee to hire an independent contractor to evaluate the Licensee's workplace environment all of the Licensee's various nuclear facilities to ensure that said work environments fully comport with NRC's requirement that nuclear workers at all of the Licensee's nuclear facilities are free and feel free to report any perceived nuclear safety concern directly to the NRC or to the Licensee without fear of retaliation.

## **BASIS AND JUSTIFICATION**

Petitioner avers here that the Licensee refuses to consider [his] employment applications and refuses to hire Petitioner solely because of his past, present, and continuing "*protected activity*" as defined within the meaning of 10 C.F.R. 50.7, of which the Licensee was fully aware prior to and at the time that Petitioner made application for employment at Exelon et al. See, attached documents identified as **TS2009ERA00010-1 TO TS2009ERA00010-86** and codified in the upper right corner of each document.

### **A. Saporito's Employment Applications at Exelon et al.**

On May 24, 2009, Saporito sent Exelon CEO, John W. Rowe, a written "Request for Employment With Exelon Corporation" which stated in relevant part that: ". . . The undersigned has made application to your company for employment at one or more of your company's nuclear facilities. However, no offer of employment has been forthcoming. . . my position and employment at FPL ended after I reported nuclear safety concerns to FPL and directly to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. . .". **TS2009ERA00010-8 to 10** (Mr. Rowe nor any representative from the Licensee has responded to this letter to date).

#### **PETITIONER'S PRIMA FACIE CASE OF DISCRIMINATION UNDER 10 C.F.R. 50.7**

##### **1. Saporito Engaged in Protected Activity Within the Meaning of 10 C.F.R. 50.7**

Saporito identified [his] engagement in 10 C.F.R. 50.7 protected activity in the resume that [he] uploaded to the Licensee's website server. Specifically, Saporito stated in his resume that, "My job at the Palo Verde Nuclear Plant and at the South Texas Nuclear Plant ended because I raised safety concerns to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission regarding operations at those nuclear plants. . . My job at Florida Power and Light Company was terminated because I raised safety concerns to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission regarding operations at the Turkey Point Nuclear Plant. . ." **TS2009ERA00010-2**

##### **2. Exelon et al. Was Fully Aware of Saporito's Engagement in 10 C.F.R. 50.7 Protected Activity**

The Licensee became aware of Saporito's protected activity identified in Item #1 above when Saporito uploaded [his] resume to the Licensee's website server. In addition, Saporito sent Exelon's CEO, John W. Rowe, a letter on May 24, 2009, in which Saporito stated in relevant part that, ". . . my position and employment at FPL ended after I reported nuclear safety concerns to FPL and directly to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. . .". **TS2009ERA00010-9**

##### **3. Exelon et al. Took Some Adverse Action Against Saporito as a Result of Saporito's Engagement in 10 C.F.R. 50.7 Protected Activity**

The Licensee has rejected through written correspondence, at least two of Saporito's employment applications and has not further considered Saporito's other employment applications to date by either seeking to interview Saporito or by offering Saporito employment.

##### **4. Saporito Suffered Tangible Economic Loss and Damage to His Professional Reputation in the Nuclear Industry Due to the Licensee's Refusal to Hire Saporito in Violation of the Employee Protection Provisions Under 10 C.F.R. 50.7**

The Licensee's failure to offer Saporito employment resulted in Saporito remaining at [his] current job at a lower hourly rate-of-pay and benefits than [he] may have received at Exelon. In addition, the Licensee's failure to hire Saporito resulted in Saporito filing a complaint with the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) under the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974, as amended, 42 U.S.C.A. §5851 which has now become a public record available to all employers in the nuclear industry. Thus, the Licensee's refusal to hire Saporito damaged Saporito's professional reputation in the nuclear industry as a direct or indirect result of

the Licensee's flagrant violation of 10 C.F.R. 50.7 in discriminating against Saporito due to [his] engagement in protected activity as defined under 10 C.F.R. 50.7.

### CONCLUSION

The NRC places a high value on nuclear employees being free to raise potential safety concerns, regardless of the merits of the concern, to both licensee management and the NRC. Therefore, one of the goals of the NRC's Enforcement Policy is to ensure, through appropriate enforcement action against a licensee or licensee contractor (and when warranted, against the individual personally responsible for the act of discrimination), that employment actions taken against licensee or contractor employees for raising safety concerns do not have a chilling effect on the individual or others on the reporting of safety concerns. For the purposes of this guidance, discrimination should be broadly defined and should include intimidation or harassment that could lead a person to reasonably expect that, if he or she makes allegations about what he or she believes are unsafe conditions, the compensation, terms, conditions, and privileges of employment could be affected.

Section 211 of the ERA provides that no employer may discharge or otherwise discriminate against any employee with respect to compensation, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment because the employee engaged in certain protected activities. These protected activities include notifying an employer of an alleged violation of the AEA or ERA, refusing to engage in any practice made unlawful by those acts, testifying before Congress or in a Federal or State proceeding regarding any provision of these acts, or commencing, testifying, assisting, or participating in a proceeding under these acts. NRC regulations that are related to the protection of whistle blowers include: 10 C.F.R. 19.20, 30.7, 40.7, 50.7, 60.9, 61.9, 70.7, 72.10 and 76.7.

WHEREFORE, ALL THE ABOVE STATED REASONS, the NRC should GRANT Petitioner's 10 C.F.R. 2.206 request for enforcement action against Exelon et al. to protect public health and safety and to ensure for the free flow of perceived nuclear safety concerns to the NRC from the Licensee's nuclear workers at all of the Licensee's nuclear facilities accordingly.
