Enclosed for your information is a letter from Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse), dated March 26, 2003, requesting an amendment to export license XCOM1111 to add four additional companies as intermediate consignees located in China. The equipment is for installation in China's civilian nuclear power plants operating in China and those under construction and those to be constructed in China.

In order to meet an early April 2003 delivery date, Westinghouse has requested a waiver of the required waiting period in the Public Document Room.

We intend to issue the license amendment pending approval from NRC's Office of the General Counsel.
