FOR EXPIRATION OF 30 DAYS PUBLIC NOTICE FOR EXPORT  
LICENSE XCOM1111/02 FOR CHINA TO ADD ADDITIONAL  
INTERMEDIATE CONSIGNEES

On January 14, 1999 and March 22, 1999, NRC issued licenses XCOM1111 and XCOM1111/01 to Westinghouse Electric Company (Westinghouse) which authorized the export of all Appendix A (5) through A (9) nuclear components to all Chinese nuclear power plants in China and several intermediate consignees. By letter dated March 26, 2003, the licensee requested an amendment to the license to add four additional intermediate consignees located in China. The licensee has requested a waiver of the 30-day waiting requirement of the amendment request in the public document room in order to meet an early April 2003 delivery date.

The original license was issued only after it was determined that the export met all the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission rules and regulations, Title 10, Chapter 1, part 110.

Under NRC regulations found at 10 CFR Section 110.82 members of the public are afforded 30 days to file an intervention petition or hearing request from the date that an amendment request of this type has been received by the NRC's Public Document Room (PDR). Although the 30 days has not expired, because of the non-controversial nature of the export, the fact the original application was posted in the PDR without an intervention petition being filed, and the need for the license to be amended to meet the shipping schedule, I am issuing the license amendment at this time.

The waiver of this 30-day requirement is authorized by law and meets all the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act as amended.
