Dear Ms Kock:

As you are aware AREVA Enrichment Services is in the licensing process with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to construct their Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility (EREF), which will be located approximately 20 miles west of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Rocky Mountain Power is the electrical utility which will be supplying electric service to the EREF through 2 separate 161 kv transmission lines. These 2 transmission lines have been proposed specifically to serve AREVA's EREF. If it were not that AREVA had requested electrical service from Rocky Mountain Power, we would not be designing the transmission lines being proposed; furthermore, if the EREF is not built, then Rocky Mountain Power will not need, nor will they construct any transmission lines into that area.
