The purpose of this note is to confirm that we will be sampling three wells across the canal tomorrow (Wednesday May 27th). We should have the analytical results by the end of the day Thursday. The three wells are W-1 (Cohannsy), W-2C (Cohannsy) and W-2K (Kirkwood). There are no nearby Cape May wells. The results from these three wells should support our current conceptual model: that the plume is unlikely to migrate under, and westward past, our canal system.
