Dear Mr. Roberts:


In a recent discussion with your office, I was informed that soils at the above referenced site had become contaminated with radiation due to a leak of the radiation chamber. It is my understanding that said soils have been removed and there is no further threat to the environment from this incident.

As you are aware, there is a continuing study being conducted of the ground water by order of the D.E.P., Division of Water Resources. As there are several private homes, and a pending subdivision of the approximately 26 homes within one mile of this site, we are very concerned that the quality of the ground water be protected.

The Rockaway Township Health Department will be sampling some of the homes along Denmark Road and forward the same to your office, as per our telephone conversation, for radiation analysis. I would also like to request that this office be copied on any correspondence with regard to Process Technology so we may stay informed of the remediation of the site.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
