Dear Hearing Docket Staff,

December 7, 2009 is the deadline for petitioning for a hearing regarding Nuclear Fuel Services' application for a 40-year license renewal. However, a request for an extension of the deadline until January 20, 2010 has been made. Attached, please find that extension request letter.

Still, despite the likelihood of obtaining the extension, potential co-petitioners are requesting, with this email message, a digital ID certificate within the 10-day deadline noted in the Federal Register Notice of October 6, 2009 (Vol. 74, No. 192, p. 51323).

Currently, there are two potential co-petitioners -- Sierra Club and Erwin Citizens Awareness Network -- and neither has counsel, although an attorney is being sought. Other organizations or individuals may also petition for hearing, but, this request for a Digital ID is being made only on behalf of the following two public interest groups:
