REMARKS: IMC 1252 (Construction Inspector Training and Qualification Program) has been revised to reflect changes in the IMC 1252 appendices and to update Attachment 4, "Construction Inspector Qualification Requirements for Inspectors Previously Qualified under IMC1245 or IMC1246 Signature Card and Division Director Certification."

IMC 1252 Appendix A (Construction Inspector Basic-Level Training and Certification Journal) been revised to add and remove individual study activities, add rotation training activities, and make editorial changes.

IMC 1252 Appendix B (Construction Inspector General Proficiency-Level Training and Qualification Journal) has been revised to add and remove training activities, incorporate references, combine the general proficiency-level with the technical proficiency-level training activities, and make editorial changes.

IMC 1252 Appendix C (Construction Inspector Post Qualification Requirements, Continuing and Refresher Training) has been revised to: (1) remove the training activities required during qualification and (2) incorporate post-qualification requirements, refresher training and continuing training.

IP 71114.02 (Alert and Notification System Evaluation) has been revised to reflect changes in inspection requirements and guidance pertaining to: (1) the FEMA-approved siren system design report and (2) evaluation of back-up means of notifications for non-siren alert and notification systems.

In addition the number of hours allowed for inspections has been revised in accordance with the 2009 Reactor Oversight Program realignment. References to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) have been changed to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
