Dear Commissioner Ahearne:



Dear Mr. Hendrie:

I am working with Chairman Arthur Katzman of the Environmental Protection Committee to prepare a hearing on the enclosed Resolution.

We are particularly concerned, as we know you are, about the safety, health and evacuation problems in the continued functioning of the Indian Point plants. The physical and psychological impact on New York City's seven and one-half million population impels us to deal concretely with such questions as:

- The continued licensing of Plants 1, 2 and 3.
- The ability to create sufficient safety mechanisms within the plants.
- The feasibility of a workable population evacuation plan.

The New York City Council would deeply appreciate your testimony on these and other critical matters before the Environmental Protection Committee, or that of your designated representative.


