Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License", together with forty (40) copies of Attachments I and II thereto, comprising a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.

This application seeks to amend Section 3.5, 4.1, and 6.9.2 of Appendix A to the Operating License. The proposed changes add a limiting condition for operation and a surveillance requirement in accordance with your October 7, 1981 and November 18, 1981 letters. These letters requested proposed Technical Specifications for NUREG-0737 item II.F.1.2 which provides for sampling of radioiodine and particulates in the plant effluent.

The proposed page changes to the Technical Specifications are contained in Attachment I to the Application for Amendment of the Operating License enclosed with this letter. The Safety Evaluation for the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications is contained in the Attachment II to the Application for Amendment.

The Authority has classified this Application for Amendment to the Operating License as Class III since acceptability for these changes is clearly identified by the Commission's October 7, 1981
