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

Dear Sir:

Our letter of January 13, 1983 (IPN-83-51) served to submit an application for an Operating License Amendment and proposed changes to the Technical Specifications. However, inadvertently the document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," was not notarized. This letter serves to resubmit the application for Operating License Amendment with the proper notarization. We regret any inconvenience this may have caused.

Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," together with forty (40) copies of Attachment I and II thereto, comprising a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.


This application seeks to amend Sections 2.1, 2.3, 3.1 and 3.10 of Appendix A (Technical Specifications) to the Operating License. The proposed changes result from an Appendix K Emergency Core Cooling System (ECCS) reanalysis performed for a steam generator equivalent tube plugging level of twenty-four (24) percent. This analysis was completed using the NRC approved 1981 Westinghouse evaluation model and demonstrates that the Indian Point 3 facility fully complies with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.46 and the February 11, 1980 Confirmatory Order. The ECCS reanalysis is included in Attachment III. The proposed changes also delete references to three-loop operating since IP-3 is restricted to 10% power or less for less than four-loop operation.

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The Authority has classified this application for amendment to the operating license as Class III since it involves the single safety issue of the ECCS reanalysis. A check in the amount of \$4,000 was enclosed in our letter of January 13, 1982 as the filing fee per 10 CFR 170.22. As this letter constitutes a resubmittal of the Application for Operating License Amendment contained in our January 13, 1983 letter, an additional payment is not applicable.
