Proposed Changes to the Technical Specifications

Dear Sir:

Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," together with forty (40) copies of Attachment A and Attachments I and II thereto, comprising a discussion of deficiencies and a statement of the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.

This application serves to amend certain sections of Appendix A to the Operating License, which were previously deferred in the Authority's September 29, 1980 letter (IPN-80-89), to be consistent, where appropriate and where possible, with portions of the Westinghouse Standard Technical Specifications (W-STTS), pursuant to the Commission's July 7, 1980 letter. Attachment A to this letter describes the actions the Authority has taken to date with respect to those deficiencies identified in the Commission's July 7, 1980 letter which the Authority committed to respond to upon completion of appropriate evaluations. The remaining specifications which were deferred in our September 29, 1980 letter were either addressed in our December 30, 1980 letter (IPN-80-118) or in our response to the Commission's June 11, 1980 letter regarding reactor decay heat removal capability (IPN-83-65 dated July 5, 1983).

As indicated in our September 29, 1980 letter, the Authority has determined that this "Application for Amendment to Operating License" is exempt from a licensing fee per Footnote 2 to 10 CFR 170.22.


