Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License", together with forty (40) copies of Attachments I and II thereto, comprising the appropriate revisions to the affected Technical Specifications pages, and the associated Safety Evaluation.

This application seeks to delete Appendix B, Part I of the Operating License in its entirety. The proposed change is a result of the aquatic requirements provided by Appendix B, Part I now being under the jurisdiction of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) as delegated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency which was established by the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972. The NYSDEC, being the regulating agency, is notified of any State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit violations and of any proposed changes thereto. Since the NRC is not the regulating agency, it is not appropriate for there to be a license condition requiring the NRC to be informed of any violations of or changes to the SPDES permit. Documentation pertaining to any violation of or changes to the SPDES permit is stored at Indian Point 3 and can be examined by an I&E Inspector at any time.

As per 10 CFR 170.12, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$150.00 in payment of the application fee for the review of these proposed changes to the Technical Specifications.

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.91, a copy of this application for amendment to the Operating License and the associated attachment is being submitted to the designated New York State Official.
