Your April 9, 1985 letter stated that the Authority's February 17, 1984 submittal_of proposed Technical Specification changes for certain NUREG-0737 items were not exempt from the fees pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 (March 23, 1978) per Footnote 2 thereto. The Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation has determined that a Class III fee of \$4,000 is appropriate for the February 17, 1984 application as the review will involve consideration of a single safety issue. Accordingly, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$4,000 in payment of the applicable fees. It should be noted that the Authority is paying this fee under protest, pending resolution of the legality of the fee schedule.
