Dear Sir:

This letter transmits a revised Section 3.1.A.1.h. of the Authority's proposed LTOPS Technical Specifications submitted by Reference 1. The revision incorporates the LTOPS temperature related instrument errors into the Technical Specifications.

The Authority has recently performed a reevaluation of the proposed LTOPS Technical Specifications. The results of this effort indicate that by including process measurement uncertainties, the control room operators' use of the LTOPS Technical Specifications will be simplified and enhanced. Details concerning this reevaluation are provided in the attached Safety Evaluation.

The Authority requests that the license amendment be made effective 90 days after its issuance. This period is necessary to allow implementation of operator training and plant procedures which will have to be significantly revised to support the approved LTOPS Technical Specifications.

Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled "Application for Amendment to Operating License", together with forty (40) copies of Attachments I and II thereto, comprising a revision to parts of the previously proposed LTOPS Technical Specifications and the associated Safety Evaluation.

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


APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO  
OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), the Power Authority of the State of New York, as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-64, hereby applies for an Amendment to the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of this license.

By letter dated July 1, 1985, the Authority submitted proposed changes to various sections of the Technical Specifications related to the Low Temperature Overpressure Protection System (LTOPS). The present application revises and supercedes entirely the previously proposed Section 3.1.A.1.h. This revision is a result of incorporating into the Technical Specifications the LTOPS temperature related instrument errors.

The revision to the previously proposed changes to the Technical Specifications are presented in Attachment I to this application. The corresponding Safety Evaluation is included in Attachment II.
